

ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE TO ALL ONTARIO ELECTRICITY CUSTOMERS

B2M Limited Partnership has applied to increase the amount it charges to transmit electricity in Ontario.

Learn more. Have your say.

B2M Limited Partnership has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for approval of a five-year plan to set the amount it charges to transmit electricity. If the application is approved as filed, it would result in the following impacts on the monthly bill of a typical Hydro One Networks Inc. residential customer and general service customer:

Any change to the provincial transmission rate will cause a change to the delivery line on all electricity bills for all electricity customers in Ontario – both residential and business.

It is important to review the application carefully for a complete list of approvals.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider B2M LP's requests. We will also hear questions and arguments from individuals and from groups that represent B2M LP's customers. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide what, if any, rate increase will be allowed.

If B2M LP's application is approved as filed, the OEB's review in years 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024 will generally be limited to ensuring certain annual formulaic adjustments are made in accordance with the approved rate plan. The formulaic adjustments are tied to inflation and other factors intended to promote efficiency.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review B2M LP's application on the OEB's website now.
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by **September 9, 2019** or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.

ORAL VS. WRITTEN HEARINGS

There are two types of OEB hearings – oral and written. B2M LP has applied for a written hearing. The OEB is considering this request. If you think an oral hearing is needed, you can write to the OEB to explain why by **September 9, 2019**.

PRIVACY

If you write a letter of comment, your name and the content of your letter will be put on the public record and the OEB website. However, your personal telephone number, home address and email address will be removed. If you are a business, all your information will remain public. If you apply to become an intervenor, all information will be public.

This rate hearing will be held under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998 c.15 (Schedule B).
